NDJFMA Climatological Rainfall Bias (1982–2014) compared to APHRODITE

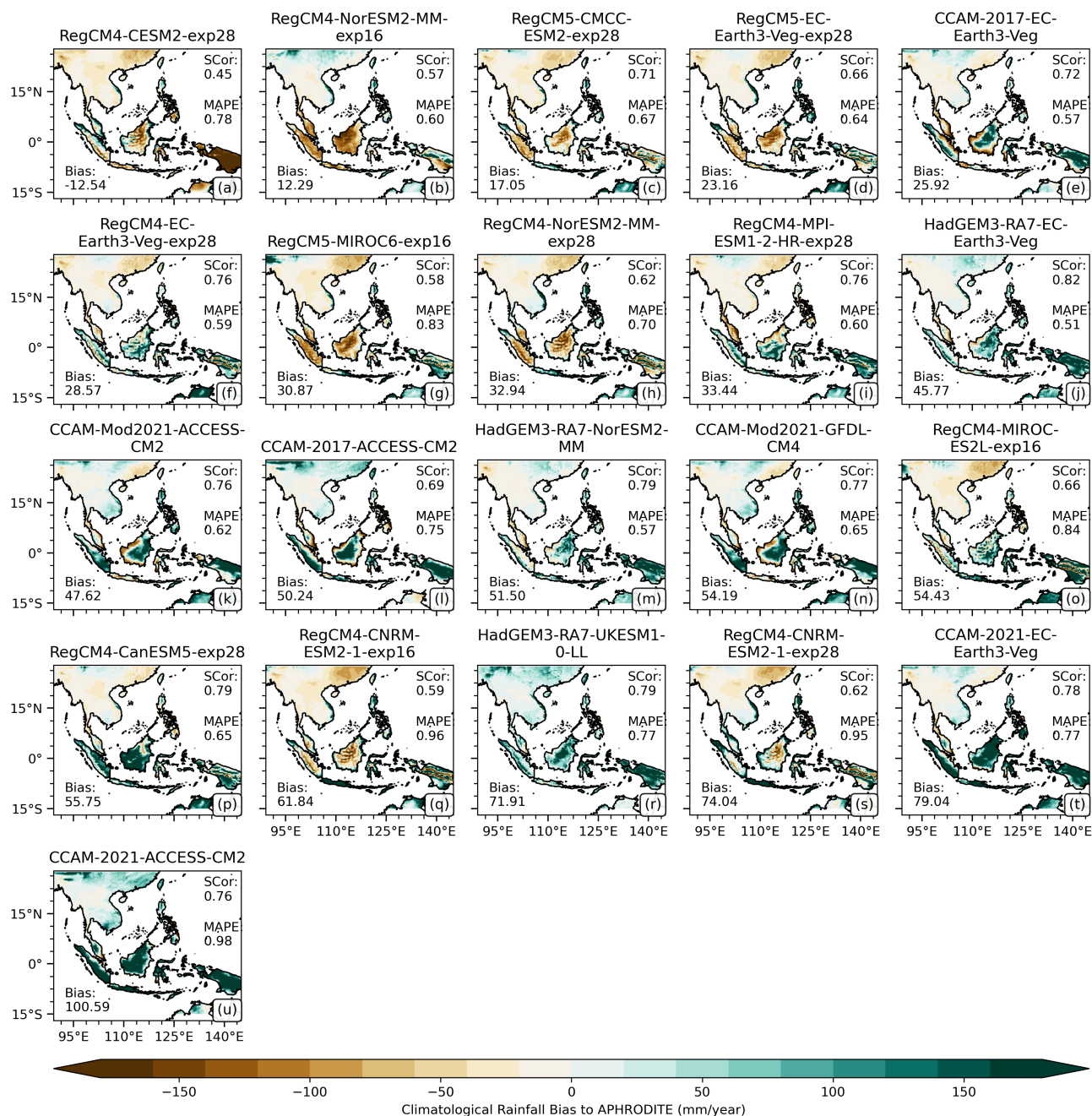


Figure 7. Same as Fig. 6 but for the November–April (NDJFMA) season.
